

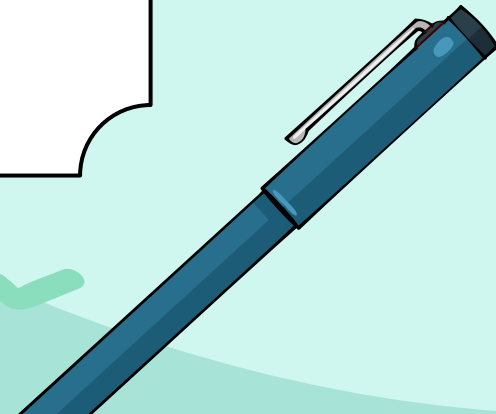

If the frequency of visits is a concern, the teacher may contact you.

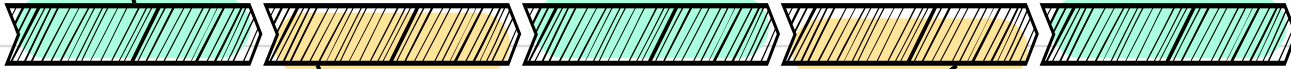



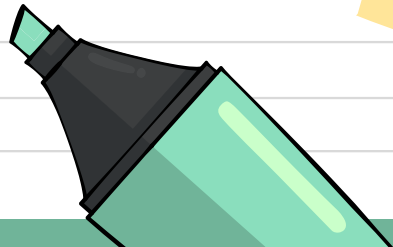
The second book is provided in line with our reading programme. The children will have read this book in class with the teacher too. These books contain a sticker that demonstrates which John Keble reading level they are at.

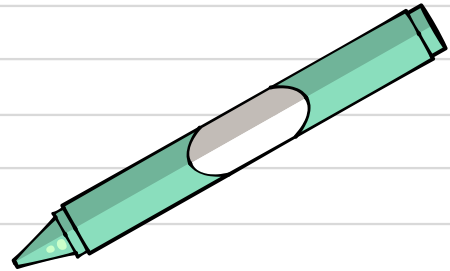




Digital Safety

- No phones are allowed in school.



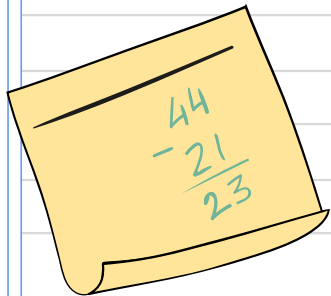
Additional Needs
