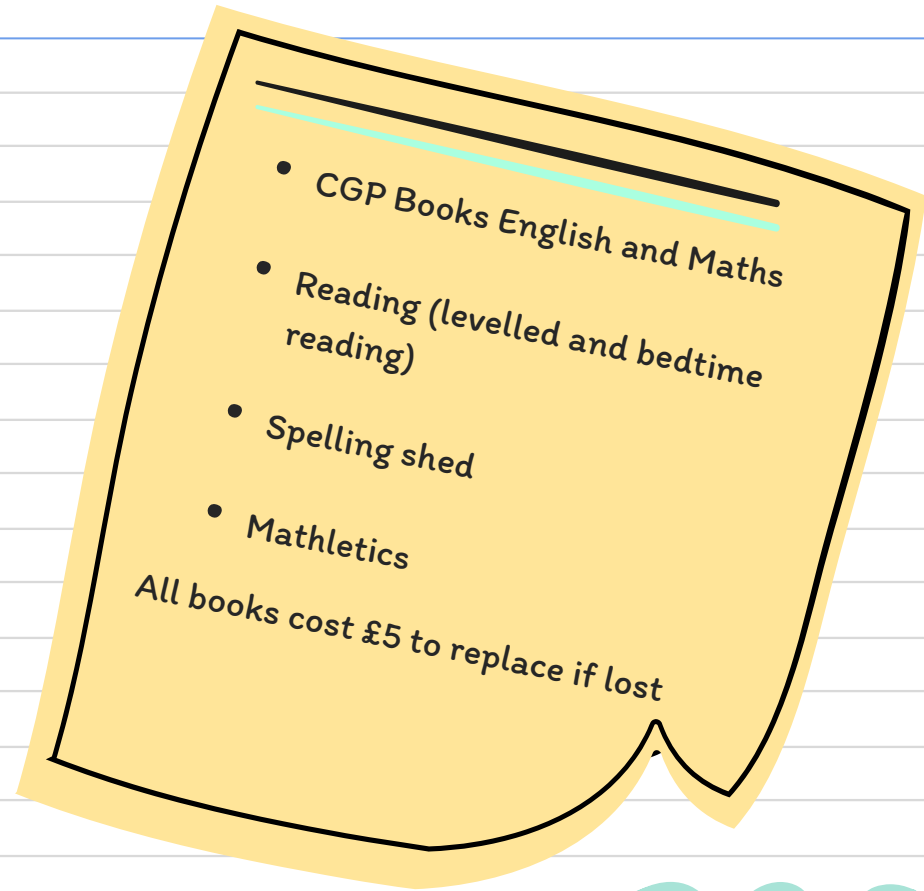

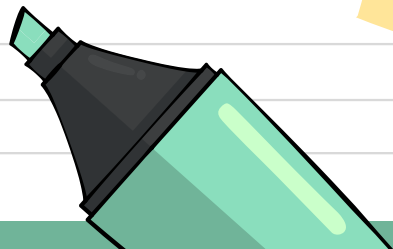


# Medication

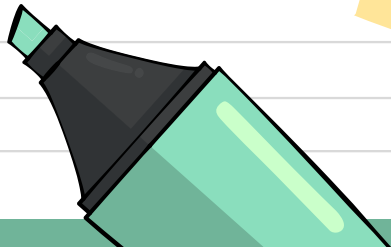


# End of day

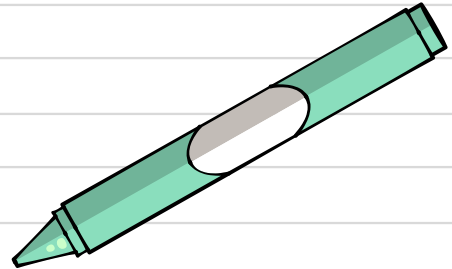




# Digital Safety
