Use algorithms to programme superheroes' vehicles on autopilot. Getting them to where they're needed quickly.

Create digital portraits, using copy and paste methods to create images inspired by Andy Warhol

Research the lives of famous monarchs of Great Britain including both Elizabeths and Victoria.

Create portraits, both realistic, abstract and caricature. We will look at famous depictions of monarchs as well as the work of Picasso.

Listen to and play with famous superhero themes, creating lyrics to some well-known melodies and symphonies.
